 therefore make this my last Will & Testament
 hereby revoking and annulling all others here-
 before made by me.

Item First - I desire and direct that all my just
 debts be paid without delay by my executor
 hereinafter named as I am unwilling my
 creditors should be delayed of their rights
 especially as there is no necessity for delay.

Item Second It is my will and desire that my
 wife Martha remain on the place with my chil-
 dren as long as she remains a widow and
 that all of my property remain on the place

and be worked in common and if my wife should marry have the estate appraised and draw out an equal share for her if she should require it and also my children as they become of age or marry they have the privilege if they desire it to draw out their distributive share of said estate

Item 3^d It is my will and desire that my wife Martha's share of my estate at her death shall be returned to my estate and equally divided between my children in the event she should marry and leave no heirs also it is my will that my property be settled on my daughters so it can not be used by any person duly as trustee agent guardian or manager.

Item 4th I constitute and appoint my worthy friend Green B. Moore executor to this my last Will and Testament this March 14th 1863.
