 all my land whereon I now reside containing
 eighty acres it being part of lot of land in number
 seven hundred (171) lying & being in the twenty second ⁽¹²²⁾ district
 of formerly Early but now Decatur County.

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my grand son
 Isaac ^{Rebelle} Griffin son of the said Len Griffin
 to wit an negro boy about six years of age
 named ^{and further bred & formation. D. 1840} Henry and also appoint his Father
 the said Len Griffin as his Guardian to take
 charge of said negro boy & formation until he arrives
 at the age of twenty one years.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha
 L. Nicholson an negro boy about fourteen years
 old which is now in her possession and then
 to remain during her life but to be returned to
 to my Estate after my decease and also all the
 share of my said Estate is in like manner
 to be returned to the estate after her death to be
 equally divided between all my children that
 may be in life at that time.

Item 4th The rest of my property of all kind what-
 ever that I may own at my death I give and
 bequeath to all my children whose names
 are as follows to wit - Wm Griffin Etutana

Daughter who is to have and enjoy her share of my Estate during her natural life and then to be returned to my Estate and to be equally divided as above stated
