William Powell of the
County & State aforesaid, being weak in body
but of sound mind and disposing memory
& knowing that it once appointed for all
men to die do make ordain & appoint
this my last will & Testament.

Item first. I resign my soul to God and my
body to the dust, to be buried at the discretion
of my friends, and whereas it has pleased God
to bless me with some of the worldly affairs
do give and dispose of in manner and
form as follows viz.—

Item

I give & bequeath unto son Reddy Powell
two negro slaves towt. Prentiss a man a
bout twenty five years old and Sarah a
girl. also fifteen hundred dollars in cash
Also four hundred & ninety (490) acres of land
being Lot no. one hundred & sixty two (162) in
the Eleventh district of Originally Swan
County but now DeKalb County, also (250)
two hundred and fifty acres of land being
Lot number eighty six (86) in the twenty
eighth District of Originally but now De-
kalb County and also all the rest of

the property that I have heretofore given
him. To have & to hold the aforesaid property
unto him my said son ~~Franklin~~^{Decatur County, Georgia Wills} Powell his heirs

Truluck fifteen hundred dollars (1500) in cash
and the property that I have already heretofore
given unto her.

4th

I give and bequeath unto my Louisa Bruce
one negro Slave to wit, Lucy a woman
also fifteen hundred dollars in cash
also the property I have heretofore given unto
her. To have and to hold the aforesaid prop-
erty unto unto her my said daughter Louisa
Bruce her heirs and assigns for ever.

5th

I give and bequeath unto my son Franklin
Powell two hundred and fifty acres of
land being lot number Twenty one in the
Sixteenth district of originally Early but
now Decatur County. also two hundred &
fifty acres of land being lot number six-
ty five in the fifteenth district of origin-
ally Early but now Decatur County. &
Two hundred & fifty acres of land being
lot number nineteen in the fifteenth
district of originally Early but now
Decatur County. To have and to hold
the aforesaid property unto him my said
son Franklin Powell his heirs & assigns for ever

6th

I give and bequeath unto my son William
Powell (250) two hundred & fifty acres of land
being lot number twenty one (21) in the
fifteenth (15) District of originally Early

3rd but now DeCatur County also Lot number
Twenty (20) in the same County & District
also Lot number Sixty in the same County
also District each containing two hundred
Fifty Acres be the sum more or less.
We have it to hold to the aforesaid property unto
my said son William Powell his heirs &
a signs forever.

4th.

I also will that all the balance of the prop-
erty that I am possessed of to be equally
divided between my wife Sarah Powell, Frank-
lin Powell my son, my daughter Margaret
Powell my son William Powell & my daugh-
ter Sarah Powell & my daughter Elizabeth
Powell Which division I wish to take place
when my son Franklin Powell arrives at
the age of twenty one years, or sooner provi-
ded my Executors herein after named may
deem fit & proper for a division to take
place sooner than the time above named.

5th

It is my will the one sixth part of my estate
be apportioned in the seventh section to my
wife Sarah Powell and my youngest children
to wit: Franklin Powell Margaret Powell
(my Daughter), my son William Powell &
my two youngest daughters Sarah Powell
& Elizabeth Powell be her property during
her natural life, and after her death to be
equally divided among my five last men-
tioned and youngest children, and should any
of my said last mentioned youngest chil-
dren die before they arrive at the age
of twenty one years then it is my will that
all the property herein bequeathed to them
be equally divided among the survivors.

last-mentioned youngest children, the lot
number twenty in the fifteenth district of
originally Early but now Decatur County,
bequeathed unto my son William Powell.
It is my will that my wife Sarah Powell
shall have during her natural life & after
her death to revert back to my said son William
Powell.

9th

It is my will that should my sons Franklin Pow-
ell or William Powell or either of them die
before they come to the age of twenty one years
that the Land herein bequeathed to the one that
should live, that the survivor shall have the
land if the one should die & should they both
die then it is my will that all the land bequeath-
ed to them both be equally among all of my chil-
dren.

10th

I give & bequeath unto my grand son William
Powell five hundred (\$500) dollars in Cash to be
paid when of division takes place of my Estate
when my son Franklin becomes of lawful
age & my Executors herein after named should
have a division of my estate before that time
and should my said grand son die before
he arrives at the age of twenty one years then
it is my will that the five hundred dollars
bequeathed unto him go to my son Hedor
Powell.

11th

I give and bequeath unto John Morris the sum
of one hundred dollars on account of his

inabilities, he having been so unfortunate
as to loose one of his ^{Deccat County, Georgia Wills} other old-est-his shall take off ¹⁸²⁹⁻¹⁸³⁸
of money herein bequeathed to ^{Note: Right binding} them, which
of one hundred dollars I recommend him
to lay out in Cattle for his own use and
support.

13th

It is my will that my son Redar Powell
& Stirling Scarborough be my executors to
this my last will & Testament.

13th

And lastly I hereby ratify & confirm this &
no other to be my last will & Testament.
In testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this the fourteenth day of
November in the year of our Lord eighteen
hundred & thirty six.
