

I William Whaddon of DeCATUR County and State of Georgia
being madd of body but of sound mind and disposing memory do
make this my last will & Testament in manner and form following. I
do hereby revoke all other will or wills heretofore made by me and do hereby
Commit my soul to God that gave it and my body to the dust from
whence it came - In the first place I give & bequeath unto
my wife three several tracts of Land lying in Liberty County and
being under the Care of George Carter Son of M^r Whitely County
also all money or moneys that is now or will hereafter become due
for rents of any part or parts of said Land or Lands -

(I will not bring in what was to have been first)
My Will and aim is that all my last debts and funeral expences
be first paid out of my Estate by my Executors. —

Next - I give and bequeath to Sarah Whaddon my wife two feather Beds
and furniture and Bedsteads, also all the household furniture that belonged
to her at the time of our intermarriage, that was brought from north, also
an Iron called Perich her choice of two cows and their calves out of my Stock
also two hilly sons and pigs all one Grand prospect also I give my wife
Sarah the one half of all my kitchen furniture, likewise my Bureau and
one upping Glap also one Candle Stand six holding chairs. Also
I give my wife one gilded picture, two Glap acantens six Glap tumbles
and one half of all my Bottled Lugs & Lard & two Cutting axes and
one Iron ridge and one Wooden Wheel all the above recited articles that
had been given to my wife Sarah Whaddon in my last will & Testament
I do hereby give the whole to her and her heirs forever —

Also my will and desire is that my wife have a certain portion of any lot
of Land whereon I now live during her natural lifetime but not to have
the right or power to sell said Land the portion of Land allotted for her during
her life to stay on it shall begin on the east line of the lot on which I now
live opposite of the range of the north side of the Orchard fence until it gets
opposite of the west side of the large Camp patch running that course to the
corner of that line to the middle of a bottom thence running down the meanders
of that until it becomes a small branch thence up said branch until it strikes
the south line of said tract above mentioned to the South East corner thence along
the east line to the beginning place just above mentioned This boundary includes

all the houses on the premises together with all the chase and woodland
land within this boundary. All the above descended together with all the houses
and our houses I give during his lifetime provided she stays on the premises
until her death also one half of all the lands for her life during her pleasure
to stay on said premises also for her to have the use of the Sagen Mill & boild
during her stay now let it be understood that all of the above mentioned
property that had had any allusion to duration of lifetime is to be understood
in this way provided my wife should marry again then at the above life time
property to vest back in manner following —

My will and desin is and I do hereby request that my nephew John
Whiddon whom I have raised from a child should have all my real & personal
estate that has not been disposed of former to my wife and it is also my will
and desin that if my wife should marry again or should come from the premises
that I have left her during her widowhood or pleasure to stay on said premises
that then all the above stipulated property that was not given to my wife or
her heirs form, to go to my said nephew John Whiddon his heirs & assigns
forever. I do hereby give and bequeath unto my nephew John Whiddon all
the rest of my real and personal estate, and all & every part or partick that I may
be possessed of at the time of my decease.

I do hereby nominate and appoint John Carey & Robert Ch' Hair my
Executors to this my last will & testament. I do hereby revoke all wills or testam
hitherto made by me and do declare this my last will and testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this fourth day
of January one thousand eight hundred & thirty nine. Signed sealed pub
lished and declared to be the last will and Testament of William Whiddon
the day and date above written in the presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our
names as witnesses John Carey
