Badger his heirs and assigns all that tract or settlement of land lying in the County & State aforesaid known & distinguished as falls as follows to wit lot of land Number eight in the sixteenth District of originally Henry now D. Hall & lots number one hundred & twenty nine one hundred & thirty one hundred & fifty nine one hundred & twenty nine in the fifteenth District of originally Henry now D. Hall County except a portion of the last mentioned lot lying in the same east corner of the same South East of a branch running across the corner of said lot supposed to contain about forty acres formerly owned by George Hall & lately conveyed to David Franklin to have and to hold said lots or parcels of land as aforesaid described together with all and singular the rights numbers and appurtenances thereto or to the same in any manner belonging or appertaining to the body politic and subject and behalf of the said Joshua B.
