or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of
DeKalb & originally survey situate lying & being in the seven
teenth District (17) District of said County known & distinguished
in the plan of said District by the number fifty nine
containing two hundred two & a half acres more or less
to have and to hold said tract or parcel of land unto
him the said Joshua Floyd his heirs and assigns together
with all and singular the rights members & appurtenances
thereof to the same in any manner belonging to him and his
own proper use benefit and behoof forever in full simple
and the said A B Greenwood for himself his heirs executors
and administrators the said bargain & promise unto the said
Joshua Floyd his heirs and assigns will warrant and
forever defend the right & title thereof against themselves
and against the claim of all other persons Whomsoever
