receipt whereof to him by attorney before named hath granted
bargain sold and conveyed and by these presents doth
grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Edward L.
Jones his heirs and assigns all that half tract or
parcel of land being the North half of lot number
Twenty (20) in the fifteenth District of originally -
Henry but now DeKalb County containing one hundred
acres more or less it having and to have said half tract
or parcel of land unto him the said Edward L. Jones
his heirs and assigns together with all and singular
the rights minuts and appurtenances thereof to the same
in any manner belonging to him his own proper use
benefit and behoof forever in fee simple and the said
John Morris for himself his heirs executors & administrators
hath the said bargains premises unto the said Edward
L. Jones his heirs executors administrators and assigns
will warrant and forever defend the rights & liberties
thereof against themselves and against the claim of
all and every other person or persons whomsoever

set his hand and seal the day and year aforesaid in the
several states and colonies in presence of this his book of
the Borgia which was destroyed by fire in the Court House
of DeKalb County ³

witnesseth that the said A. S. Williford hath this
day made and delivered to the said A. S. Morris his certain
promissory note subscribed with his hand and bearing equal
date with these presents unto whom the said A. S. Williford
hath promised to pay to the said A. S. Morris or bearer three hundred
and thirty Dollars and fifty six cents for ever after date
now and forever being due for value received. Now for and
in consideration of the sum of three hundred and thirty
Dollars and fifty six cents by the said A. S. Morris to the
said A. S. Williford in hand paid the receipt of which

is hereby acknowledged as well as for the better securing
the payment of said promissory note the said A. H. Morris
hath granted bargained and sold and delivered this present
grant bargain and sale unto the said S. G. Morris his
heirs and assigns a certain negro slave female named
Eliza yellow complexion about sixteen years of age

To have and to hold said bargain property to the
said A. H. Morris his heirs and assigns to his and their
own proper use benefit and behoof for ever and
the said A. H. Williford for himself his heirs
executors administrators the said bargained property and
the said A. H. Morris will warrant and forever defend
against the claim of all other persons whatsoever

I nowe witnesseth that if the said A. H. Williford
his heirs executors and administrators shall and do will
and truly pay or cause to be paid into the said
A. H. Morris his heirs and assigns the aforementioned
sum of three hundred and thirty Dollars and Sixty
Six cents on the day and time mentioned and appointed
for the payment thereof in the said promissory note
hereinabove according to the tenor of said note then &
from thenceforth as well this present instrument and
the right to the property thence conveyed as the said
promissory note shall cease determining and be void to
all intents and purposes In testifying whereof the
