and more or less to have and to hold said half tract
or parcel of land unto him the said Edward L. Vorns
his heirs and assigns together with all and singular
the rights liberties and appurtenances thereto the same
in any manner belonging to him his own proper use
benefit and behoof forever in full fee simple and the said
John Morris for himself his heirs executors and adminis-
trators the said bargain premises unto the said Edward
L. Vorns his heirs executors administrators and assigns
will warrant and forever defend the rights & titles
thereto against themselves and against the claim of
all and every other person or persons whomsoever

and thirty Dollars and fifty six cents five years after date
and in every thing for value received Now for and
in consideration of the sum of three hundred & thirty
Dollars and fifty six cents by the said J. H. Morris to the
said J. S. Welliford in hand paid the receipt of which

is hereby acknowledged as well as for the better securing
the payment of said promissory note the said A. V. Williford
hath granted bargain and sell and doth by these presents
grant bargain and sell unto the said J. H. Morris his
heirs and assigns a certain negro slave female named
Elyza yellow complexion about sixteen years of age
to have and to hold said bargain property to the
said J. H. Morris his heirs and assigns to his and their
own proper use benefit and behoof for ever and
the said A. V. Williford for himself his heirs
Executors administrators the said bargain property and
the said J. H. Morris will warrant and defend against
again at the claim of all other persons whatsoever.

Provided nevertheless that if the said A. V. Williford
his heirs Executors and administrators shall and do well
and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said
J. H. Morris his heirs and assigns the aforementioned
sum of three hundred and thirty Dollars and sixty
six cents on the day and time mentioned and appointed
for the payment thereof in the said promissory note
mentioned according to the tenor of said note then do
from thenceforth as well the present Indenture and
the right to the property thereby conveyed as the said
promissory shall cease determine and be void to
