Six hundred Dollars or or before the twenty fifth of
December next ensuing the date hereof for value received
now for and in consideration of the sum of five
Dollars by the said Archibald Gilmer to the said Alexander
Stewart in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged as well as for the better securing the
payment of the aforesaid promissory note the said
Alexander Stewart hath granted bargained and sold
and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell
unto the said Archibald Gilmer his heirs and assigns
all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and
being in Originally King now DeKalb County bounded
as follows beginning at a white Oak on the branch
running through lot No (67) Sixty Seven No 68 to a R O X

according to the tenor of said note then & from
thence forth as well as this present indenture and
the right to the property thereby conveyed as the said

promissory note shall cease to determine and be void in
