equally divided Amongst my Children I Appoint
James W. McLain Sole Executor of this my last
Will & Testament hereby Revoking all former Wills
by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & affixed my seal this the twenty first
day of July in the Year of our Lord eighteen hun-
