This Indenture made the eighth day
of November in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and forty four between Chapman
Pawle of the State aforesaid and County of DeKalb of the aforesaid
and John Ghu of the State aforesaid and County of DeKalb
of the other part witnesseth that the said Chapman Pawle
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and
twenty five Dollars to him in hand paid at and before the delivery
and delivery of these presents to the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
heath grant to bargain sell and convey and do by
these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said
John Ghu his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel
of land situate lying and being in the County of DeKalb in
said State & known as part of lot Number one hundred
and three 103 in the eighth District of said County said parcel
of land is known as being that part of said lot wherein there
is a dam across the Peach tree Creek & a ditch or canal
to convey the water from said peach tree creek into the burr
fork Creek the land which is conveyed is to include said
dam, pond of Water & ditch or canal as it now is situated.

I have and to hold a said tract or parcel of land unto him
the said John Ghu his heirs and assigns together with all
and singular the rights, franchises and appurtenances thereto
to the claim in any manner belonging to his and their proper
use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple and the said
Chapman Pawle for himself his heirs executors and administrators
the said bargaining premises unto the said John Ghu his heirs and assigns
will warrant and forever defend the right and title thereof against
themselves and against the claim of all other persons whatever

set his hand and seal the day and year first

Dickatt County Wheras the Inferior Court of the County of Dickatt when sitting for ordinary purposes on the first Monday of November in the year Eighteen hundred and forty two upon the application of John F Wilson & James H Wilson Executors of the last will and testament of Samuel D Wilson deceased deceased an order for the sale of the real estate of said deceased herinafter described aforesaid legal notice of such application having been first given in one of the public Gazettes of this State Court in the Southern Province for four months previous to the granting of the order aforesaid and wheras the said John F Wilson & James H Wilson Executors as aforesaid having first given fifty days notice of said sale and of the time and place thereof in the public gazette aforesaid and at the door of the Court house in said County died on the first Tuesday of February in the year Eighteen hundred and forty three 1843 at the place of public sales in the County aforesaid exposed to sale at public auction under and by virtue of the order aforesaid the premises hereinabove mentioned and wheras the said premises were then and there bid off to H B Tatman who was the highest bidder for the same at and for the sum of then hundred and one dollars \$101.

Now this Indenture made the sixteenth day of May in the year Eighteen hundred and forty four and in the Sixty eighth year of the Independence of the United States of America between the said John F Wilson & James H Wilson Executors aforesaid of the County of Campbell and State aforesaid Executors aforesaid of the one part and H B Tatman of the County of Dickatt and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said John F Wilson & James H Wilson Executors as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of then hundred and one dollars in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold alienated leasen and confirmed unto the said H B Tatman his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate in the fourth with District of originally known but now Dickatt County in the State aforesaid containing two hundred two and a half acres which is known & distinguished in the plan of said district by the number two hundred and four two to have and to hold the said bargained premises with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances therof what some to the said premises being belonging to or in anywise appertaining with the remains and uses and profits thereof to the only proper use benefit and behoof of him the said Henry B Tatman his heirs Executors administrators and assigns in his simple and the said James H Wilson & John F Wilson Executors as aforesaid their heirs Executors and administrators the said bargained premises unto the said Henry B Tatman his heirs Executors administrators and assigns against all persons claiming by firm or under the said Samuel D Wilson deceased or the said James H Wilson & John F Wilson Executors as aforesaid but against no other known whereto shall and will for ever warrant and defend by virtue of these presents.

In witness whereof the said James H Wilson & John F Wilson
