And said Robert M for himself his heirs Executors
and administrators the said bargain promises unto the
said Sumstall B. will warrant & forever defend against
the claim of himself & his heirs & against the claim
of all other persons whatever. Provided nevertheless
that if the said Robert M his heirs Executors & administrators
shall & as well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto said
Sumstall his heirs and assigns the aforesaid sum of
five hundred and seven & one Dollars on the day and time
mentioned and appointed for the payment thereof in the
said promissory note mentioned with lawful interest
for the same according to the tenor of said note
then and from thence forth as well the present in-
terest and the right to the property thereby conveyed as
the said promissory note shall cease determine and be

one fourth acre of land more or less lying

on or before the first day of March Eighteen hundred and
forty five with interest from the twenty fifth day of August
last for value received. Now for and in consideration
of the sum of six Dollars by the said Peter Ball to the said
James Ball in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
as well as for the better securing the payment of the aforesaid
promissory notes the said James Ball hath granted bargained
sold and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell unto
the said Peter Ball his heirs and assigns all three tracts
or parcels of land known and distinguished as lot No
three hundred and fifty six (356) and fraction No three hundred
and fifty three (353) both in the Sixth District of Original
Sixteenth now DeKalb County the lot containing two hundred
and fifty acres and the fraction containing one hundred
and ninety two acres more or less. To have and to hold
