in originally Henry now DeKalb County Georgia and distin-
guished by lot number fifty in the Seventeenth District

to have and to hold said lot as a bona discretio so far
as his power as Executor shall extend unto Robert H.
Smith his heirs and assigns together with all & singular
the rights therein to against himself his heirs Executors
and administrators and all other persons or persons what-

 Cobb and State aforesaid of the one part and James Phillips
 of the County of DeKalb and State aforesaid of the other
 Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of Three
 Hundred Dollars to him in hand paid at and before the
 sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged the said John Reeves has this day
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant
 sell and convey unto the said James Phillips his
 heirs and assigns all that Tract or parcel of Land
 situate lying and being in the Sixteenth District of origin-
 ally Henry now DeKalb County within and distinguished
 in the plan of said District by the number sixty six (66) it-
 being the south part of said Lot. Containing one hundred
 and forty acres more or less to have and to hold
 the said bargained premises to him the said James
 Phillips his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple
 and I the said John Reeves for myself my heirs and
 assigns unto the said James Phillips his heirs and
 assigns the right and title to the said bargained pre-
 mises with warrant and forever defend against themselves
