County it being all of said lot except fifty acres in the North East
corner of said lot the balance conveyed by these presents containing

forever to have and to hold in fee simple and the said John
C Clark doth hereby warrant and forever defend said bargained premises
to her the said Margaret her heirs and assigns forever from

thirteenth day of April next inclosing the date hereof
for value Recd. Two for and in consideration of the
sum of five dollars to the said David S. Floyd in hand
paid by the said John Collin the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged as well as for the better securing the pay-
ments of the aforesaid promissory note the said David S.
Floyd hath granted bargained sold and conveyed as
aforesaid to the said John Collin his heirs and assigns one
half of the aforesaid property to the said John Collin in full
payment of the sum of five dollars to the said David S. Floyd
as aforesaid and the said John Collin his heirs and assigns
are to have and to hold the said
bargained property to the said John Collin in full

his heirs Executors and administrators the said bargained
property unto the said John Collie will warrant and
bear witness against the claim of himself & his
heirs and against the claim of all other persons
whatever provided nevertheless that if the said David
J. Floyer his heirs Executors and administrators shall
and do will and testify pay or cause to be paid unto
the said John Collie his heirs and assigns the sum of
forty dollars on
the day and time mentioned and appointed for the
payment thereof in the said promissory notes mentioned
with lawful interest for the same according to the
time and effect thereof then and from thenceforth
as well this present indenture and the right to the
property thenceforward conveyed as the said promissory notes
shall pass thenceforward and be void to all intents
