eight hundred and forty two between Thomas Oliver of the state  
of Alabama and County of Randolph of the one part and Benjamin  
Little of the County and State first above written of the other part  
witnesseth That the said Thomas Oliver for and in considera-  
tion of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand  
paid at and before the sealing and delivering of these presen-  
t's receipt there is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain  
sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and convey unto the said Benjamin Little his heirs and  
assigns a certain lot of land containing three hundred and  
and one half acres be the same more or less it lying and  
being in the fourteenth district of originally Henry but  
now Dekalb County known and distinguished in the plan  
of said district by No 2055 to have and to hold the said  
lot of land together with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments and appertinances thereof  
whatsoever belonging therunto to the said Benjamin  
Little his heirs executors administrators and assigns  
to their only proper use benefit and behoof forever in fee  
simple and the said Thomas Oliver his heirs executors  
administrators and assigns shall and will warrant and  
never defend right and title thereof against the  
claims of themselves and the claims of all and every  
other person or persons whosoever claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof in witness whereof the  
said Thomas Oliver hath hereunto set my hand  
and affixed my seal this the 27 day of August 1892

to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is acknowledged  
bargained sold and granted and by these presents doth  
bargain sell alien and convey unto the said Calvin  
Holley his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of  
lying and being in the fourteenth district of originally  
Henry but now Dekalb County known and distinguished  
by a plan of said district the No 60 dirty containing  
hundred two and a half acres be the same more or  
less which said tract or parcel of land together

Singular the eight members and appurtenances thereof  
or are any wise appertaining to the said David Montgomery  
my husband assigns unto the said Calvin Holly his heirs  
and assigns will warrant and forever defend the right and  
title of the above tract or parcel of land also from all other  
claims whatever laying any claims thereto to have and  
to hold the said premises unto himself the said Calvin  
Holly his heirs and assigns forever to their own proper  
use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple in testimony  
whereof the said David Montgomery hath hereunto set  
his hand and first his seal the day and date above

sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain  
sell and convey unto the said Noah R. Reeve his heirs  
and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate  
lying and being in the County of original Survey  
but now DeKalb County known and distinguished  
in the plan of Survey by Lot Number Twenty in  
the Seventeenth District of DeKalb County containing  
two hundred two & half acres more or less to have and  
to hold said tract or parcel of land unto him the said  
Noah R. Reeve his heirs and assigns together with all  
and singular the right, members, reversion, rents, profits  
and appurtenances thereof to the same in any manner  
belonging to the said Reeve and their own proper use benefit  
and behoof forever in fee simple and the said George W.  
Egins for himself his heirs executors and administrators  
the said bargained premises unto the said Noah R.  
Reeve his heirs executors administrators and assigns  
will warrant and forever defend the right and
