land situate in the Town of Dalton in said County
Moremore and distinguished in the plan of said Town by
the number nine containing one half acre more or less
also lot number one hundred and forty one in said Town
containing one acre more or less also the North half of
number two in said Town containing one fourth of an acre
more or less also lot of land number two hundred and
forty seven in the fifteenth District of originally being
near D. Hall County containing two hundred & two and
a half acres more or less together with all and singular
the rights members and appurtenances thereof unto the said
lots or parcels of land being belonging or in any wise appertaining
and also all the estate right title interest property claim and
demand of the said John Jones his heirs and assigns in
and to the said lots and parcels of land in said County or otherwise
whatsoever of in or to the same To have and to hold the said
lots and parcels of land and premises and every part thereof
unto the said Isaac F. Moody and Joseph A Russ their
heirs and assigns to the only proper use benefit and behoof of

& remainance, reversion & reversionary rights, issues & profits
thereof to the only proper use benefit & behoof of him the
said William Ansonson his Executors administrators
& assigns in fee simple the said Duke Morton his heirs
executors & administrators the bargain Land & premises
unto the said William Ansonson his heirs Executors adminis-
trators & assigns against the said Duke Morton his heirs
administrators unto all & every other persons or persons shall &
will warrant and force defend by virtue of these presents.

sum of Two hundred Dollars to him in hand well and truly paid
by the said William Martin the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
hath granted bargained sold conveyed and by these presents
do grant bargain sell convey and confirmed unto the said
William Martin all that lot or tract of land situated lying
being in the County of DeKalb formerly Henry County and
known as number three hundred and forty three in the
twentieth lot when surveyed two hundred two and
more or less together with all and singular the rights
liberties and appertinances thereto belonging
in anywise appertaining to the said William Martin
the said Hozz Warner for himself his heirs
