Know all men by these presents that this Indenture made the 18<sup>th</sup> January in the year of our Lord 1833 between Edward L. Nash of the one part & John P. Nash of the other part witnesses that the said Edward L. Nash for and in consideration of the sum of eighty five dollars to him in hand paid at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted bargain sold & conveyed & do by these presents grant & assign all that tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County originally Henry now Dickall being sixty run in the 18<sup>th</sup> Eighteenth district originally Henry now Dickall, originally granted to James Myhand said grant being dated 22<sup>nd</sup> Novem<sup>r</sup> 1824 To have and to hold to his heirs & assigns together with all & singular the rights members & appurtenances thereof to the same in any manner belonging to his & their own proper use benefit and behoof For ever for simple and the said Edward L. Nash for himself his heirs executors & administrators the said bargain warrant and forever defend the rights & titles thereof against themselves and against the claim of all other persons whatever in witness whereof the said Edward L. Nash hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day and date above written this 18<sup>th</sup> January 1833. (in witness before)

Nash of the County of Dickall of the one part and Ada Braswell of the same place of the other part witnesses that the said James M. Nash for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain sold aliened & confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Ada Braswell his heirs and assigns all that tract or lot of land known by lot No. 342 two hundred & forty two in the Eighteenth district of formerly Henry but now Dickall County containing two hundred & two & a half acres to the same right or title. To have and to hold the said lot of land with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances thereof to the said Ada Braswell being belonging to him and his heirs
