Georgia This Indenture Made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of December in  
DeKalb County of the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
forty four between Elisha P Bolton of Henry County of the one part  
and the Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said Elisha P Bolton for and in consideration of  
menizing their contemplated Rail Road on and along his land aforesaid  
as in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid  
at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents doth give grant  
bargain and sell unto the said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company and  
their successors and assigns the right of way over which to pass at all  
times by themselves Directors Officers Agents hirelings and Servants in  
any manner they may think proper and particularly for the purpose of  
running erecting and establishing thereon a Rail Road with the appre  
site Number of tracks pursuant to a charter of incorporation passed  
the twenty first day of December eighteen hundred and thirty three  
and amended at subsequent sessions of the General Assembly by conferring  
Banking powers and the privilege of extending the road from Macon  
to the Southern terminus of the Western & Atlantic Rail Road and to this  
end the limit of said right of way shall extend in width Thirty three  
yards on each side of the centre line of the road way of the said Rail Road  
when completed and extend in length through the whole tract of land  
owned and claimed by said Elisha P Bolton situated lying and being in  
DeKalb County adjoining lands of Leonard McCarter Bolton and others  
and running in such direction through said tract of land as the said  
Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company by their lessees shall think  
best suited for the purpose of locating and establishing their works  
and connected with said right of way the said Company shall have  
the right to cut down and remove all such trees underwood and  
other growth and timber on each side of said road as would be  
falling on or shading the same injure the rails or other parts of the  
road together with all and singular the rights, incumbrances  
appurtenances to the said strip tract or parcel of land being belonging  
in any wise appertaining and more especially the right of way and  
same to have and to hold the same unto the said Georgia Rail & Banking  
Company their successors and assigns to their uses for purposes  
and behoof forever in fee simple upon conditions and it is agreed  
understood that should the said Rail Road be completed  
be not located and established on and along said tract  
of land described in the above and foregoing

then said Indenture is to be wholly null and void and of no effect and the said Elisha P. Bolton for himself his heirs and assigns will warrant and defend the title thereto unto the Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company their successors and assigns against the claims of all persons whatsoever the witness whereof the said Elisha P. Mason for and in consideration of the sum of eighteen hundred and twenty four dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents the right wherof is hereby acknowledged by the said E. Mason for and in consideration of the sum of eighteen hundred and twenty four dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents the right wherof is hereby acknowledged by the said Thomas Moran his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of DeKalb Maine and containing unto number three hundred and thirty six (366) in the Fifth district of Brigadoon Precinct now DeKalb County containing one hundred and eighty acres more or less being the place whereon Rubin Martin now resides and on which there is a farm known by the name of Martins Ferry on the Chattahoochee River and also the ferry boat belonging to said farm.  
In token and witness whereof the said E. Mason has caused to be made a copy of this instrument and the same is acknowledged by the said E. Mason for himself his heirs executors and administrators the said bargained premises unto the said Thomas Moran his heirs and assigns will warrant and forever defend the right and title thereto against themselves and against the claim of all other persons who may be in possession of the same.
