 Whereas in Ordinance to a suit of four hundred and thirty eight acres of land situated from a Suters East of the 531st Street
 G. No. of the County of DeKalb at the suit
 of Ezzel Mason against Usha St. Simons that J. John
 W. Paul Sheriff of the County of DeKalb did lately seize
 the parcel of land hereinafter described as the property of the
 said Usha St. Simons and after the same being duly appraised
 and a sale to law did on the fifth day of April in
 the year eighteen hundred and forty two at the place of public
 sales in the said County of DeKalb expose the same at public
 outcry when Ezzel Mason being the highest bidder the same
 was knocked off to him at the price or sum of four hundred
 Dollars
 Now this deed made the second day of May
 in the year eighteen hundred and forty two between the said
 John W. Paul Sheriff as aforesaid of the one part and
 the said Ezzel Mason of the other part Witnesseth that
 the said John W. Paul Sheriff as aforesaid for and in
 consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars to him
 in hand paid by the said Ezzel Mason at and before the
 selling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and
 by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey for
 the office of Sheriff authorizes him unto the said Ezzel
 Mason his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land
 situate lying and being in the town of Decatur known and
 distinguished in the plan of said town by lot number
 thirty eight (38) and North East half of lot number thirty
 seven (37) together with all of the improvements on said
 lots together with all and singular the rights members and
 appurtenances thereof and also all the estate right title
 interest claim and demand of the said Usha St. Simons
 in law equity or otherwise whatsoever of in or to the same
 to have and to hold the said premises and every part thereof
 unto the said Ezzel Mason his heirs and assigns in
 as full and ample a manner as the said Usha St. Simons
 or his heirs and assigns did hold and enjoy or might lawfully
 hold and enjoy the same had it not been seized & sold
 under the Execution aforesaid
