Witness in Ordinance to a suit of partition
issued from a Justice Court of the 5th Judicial
Ct. of the County of DeKalb at the suit
of Elisha H. Stinson against Elisha H. Stinson that J. Schu-
ler Sheriff of the County of DeKalb did lately seize
the parcel of land hereinafter described as the property of the
said Elisha H. Stinson and after the same being duly exam-
ined and found to be the property of the said Elisha H. Stinson
did on the fifth day of April in
the year eighteen hundred and forty two at the place of public
sale in the said County of DeKalb expose the same at public
sale when Elisha H. Stinson being the highest bidder the same
was knocked off to him at the price or sum of four hundred
Dollars
Now this deed made the second day of May
in the year eighteen hundred and forty two between the said
John W. Schuler Sheriff as aforesaid of the one part and
the said Elisha H. Stinson of the other part Witnesseth that
the said John W. Schuler Sheriff as aforesaid for and in
consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars to him
in hand paid by the said Elisha H. Stinson at and before the
making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold unto
by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto
the office of Sheriff authorizes him unto the said Elisha H. Stinson
his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land
situate lying and being in the town of Decatur known and
distinguished in the plan of said town by lot number
thirty eight (38) and North East half of lot number thirty
seven (37) together with all of the improvements on said
lots together with all and singular the rights members and
appurtenances thereof and also all the estate right title
interest claim and demand of the said Elisha H. Stinson
in law equity or otherwise whatsoever of in or to the same
to have and to hold the said premises and every part thereof
unto the said Elisha H. Stinson his heirs and assigns in
as full and ample a manner as the said Elisha H. Stinson
or his heirs and assigns did hold and enjoy or might law-
fully and enjoy the same had it not been seized & sold
under the Execution aforesaid
