This indenture made the twenty second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight and in the fifty third year of the Independence of the United States of America between Elisha Trammell of the County of Clark of the one part and Thomas Kennedy of the County of DeKalb of the other part Witnesseth that the said Elisha Trammell for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Thomas Kennedy his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the 14th fourteenth of originally Fayette now DeKalb County known and distinguished in the plan of said district by the Number (9) nine containing two hundred and a half acres more or less To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the rights tenements and appurtenances thereof whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of Land being belonging or in any wise appertaining to the remainder and remainders reversion and accensions rents issues and profits thereof to the only proper use benefit and behoof of him the said Thomas Kennedy his heirs executors administrators and assigns in fee simple and the said Elisha Trammell his heirs executors and administrators the said bargained premises unto the said Thomas Kennedy his heirs executors and administrators and assigns against the said Elisha Trammell his heirs executors and administrators and all and every other person or persons shall and lawfully forever warrant and defend by virtue of these presents In witness whereof the said Elisha Trammell hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
