of the State and County of DeKalb of the one part and
Amos Williams of the State of Georgia and County of DeKalb of the
other part Witnesseth that the said William J. and Elizabeth Jennings
for and in consideration of the sum Two hundred and twenty five
Dollars to them in hand paid at and before the making
and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and do by
these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said
Amos Williams his heirs and assigns with that tract or
parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of DeKalb
and originally Henry County Georgia and distinguished in the
plan of said County the one as lot Number One Hundred and nine
in the Eighteenth District containing Two hundred two and
one half acres more or less and the other as twenty five acres in the
North West corner of Lot Number Fifty eight in the Eighteenth District
both of said parcels of Land being now in the County of DeKalb
in said State.

To have and to hold said tracts or parcels of Land
unto him the said Amos Williams his heirs and assigns together
with all and singular the Rights Members and appurtenances
thereof to the same in any manner belonging to him and his
own proper use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple and
the said William J. Jennings and Elizabeth Jennings for themselves
