by these presents do hereby sell and confirm all that

of Henry formerly now DeKalb and in the plan of said county
located in the fifteenth District fully & fairly known by lot
(2130) one hundred and thirty six have and to hold
the aforesaid lot of land with all and singular the rights
members and appurtenances and the aforesaid W Bent-
coate attorney aforesaid do hereby warrant & forever defend
the above described premises from the claim or claims of
the aforesaid John Knight his heirs & assigns to the aforesaid
Elijah Bird his heirs executors & administrators and every other

Witnesseth that the said Galen Johnson for and in consideration
of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath this day bargained
and sold unto the said Elijah Bird and by these presents
do bargain and sell into the said Elijah Bird his heirs and
assigns a certain lot or parcel of Land lying and being in
the fifteenth District of originally Henry now DeKalb County
except that part of the lot or parcel lying on the South east corner
South East of the branch the branch being the line (supposed
forty acres) and known in the plan of said district by
number one hundred and twenty seven 127 lying near
the waters of Sheep finger To have and to hold the above
described lot of land to gether with all and singular
rights members and appurtenances thereto

belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said land and said
John Johnson doth bind himself his heirs and assigns to whom
and forever defend the rights and title of the aforesaid tract of
land against himself his heirs and assigns and against
the claims or claims of any other person or persons whomsoever
the said Elijah Bird his heirs and assigns and for his own
benefit and behoof in fee simple forever in writing where

his heirs assigns if a certain piece or parcel of land lying in
DeKalb County in the State of Georgia and known and
described as follows unto west; Lot number eight in the
Sixteenth District of originally Henry now DeKalb County
and lots number one hundred and twenty nine one hundred
and thirty one hundred and fifty nine and one hundred and three
seven in the fifteenth District of originally Henry now DeKalb
County except a portion of the last mentioned lot lying in
the south east corner of the same south east of a branch run-
ning across the corner of said lot supposed to contain about
forty acres formerly owned by George Hale and lately conveyed
to David Franklin to have and to hold the above described
land with all and singular every thing thereon or in
any wise appertaining and do further covenant and agree
that I will forever warrant and defend the title to said
