Witnesseth that the said Thomas Woods for and no considerations of the  
sum of eight hundred dollars to him in hand paid at and before  
the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and does by  
these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Georgia Rail  
Road and Banking Company and their assigns all that abstract or lots  
of land situate lying and being in the sixteenth district originally Henry  
now Dekalb County, known by numbers one hundred and sixty nine (169),  
one hundred and seventy (170) to have and to hold said tract or  
parcels of land unto them the said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Compa-  
ny, and their assigns together with all and singular the rights  
members and appurtenances there of to the same in any manner be-  
longing to their own proper use hereof and be long forever in full  
simple. And the said Thomas Woods for himself his heirs executors  
and administrators the said bargain and promises unto the said  
Georgia Rail Road & Banking company and their assigns will  
warrant and forever defend the right and title therof against them-  
selves and against the claims of all other persons whatever. In witness
