Witnesseth that the said Charles Murphy for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Ezekiel Mason at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given to bargained to the said Charles Murphy to be by these presents donee grant bargain sell release convey and confirm unto the said Ezekiel Mason his heirs and assigns all that piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in the town of Dalton Dalton County known and distinguished in the plan of said Town as part of lot Number thirty three and commencing on the Shallowford Shut on Russell line and running twenty four feet south on the east line of lot Number thirty three line west thirty six feet back into said lot thirty three lines due North from said line running East to the beginning comes on the Shallowford Shut together with all and singular the rights, members and appurtenances thereof whatsoever to the said piece of land being belonging to in anywise appertaining and the remains and remains unto him and profits thereof and every part thereof to have and to hold the said piece of land and all the singular the franchises and appurtenances thereto belonging as aforesaid and every part thereof unto the said E. Mason his heirs and assigns forever and the said Charles Murphy and his heirs the said bargained lot of land and franchises aforesaid and every part thereof unto the said E. Mason his heirs and assigns against him the said Charles Murphy and his heirs and all and every other person and persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forum defend by these presents.
