

State of Georgia This Indenture made on the County of Fulton 3 day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty two between George Schley of the City of Savannah in the State and County aforesaid of the first part and the Bank of the State of Georgia of the second part witnesseth that whereas the said George Schley stands and at the date of these presents justly & truly indebted to the said The Bank of the State of Georgia in the sum of eight hundred dollars upon his certain promissory note for that amount now running in the said Bank dated the twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord aforesaid payable to William Law fifty one days after its date executed and delivered by the said William Law to the said Bank of the State of Georgia And whereas the said George Schley also stands indebted at the date of these presents in the further sum of twenty seven hundred & fifty four dollars upon his certain other promissory note for that amount now running in the said Bank dated the twentieth day of March aforesaid payable to John Kelly fifty one days after the date thereof and executed and delivered by the said John Kelly to the said "The Bank of The State of Georgia And whereas the said George Schley also stands indebted in the further sum of nineteen hundred & seventy dollars upon his certain other promissory note for that amount now running in the said Bank dated the twenty fourth day of March aforesaid payable to John Kelly fifty one days after its date executed and delivered by the said John Kelly to the said "The Bank of the State of Georgia And whereas the said George Schley also stands indebted in the further sum of twenty three thousand and twenty dollars upon his certain other promissory note for that amount now running in the said Bank dated the twenty fourth day of March aforesaid payable to John Kelly fifty one days after its date executed and delivered by the said John Kelly to John A. Cobb and executed and delivered by the said John A. Cobb to the said "The Bank of the State of Georgia And whereas the said George Schley also stands indebted in the further sum of eight hundred dollars upon his certain other promissory note for that amount now running in the said Bank dated the thirty first day of March aforesaid payable to A. B. Davis fifty one days after its date and executed and delivered by the said A. B. Davis to the said "The Bank of the State of Georgia And whereas the said George Schley now stands further indebted to the said "The Bank of the State of Georgia in the further sum of one thousand dollars upon his certain other promissory note for that amount now running in the said Bank dated the thirty first day of March aforesaid payable to the said "The Bank of the State of Georgia" Sixty one days after the date thereof and as the said George Schley is desirous of securing "The Bank of the State of Georgia the payment of his promissory notes or of any notes that may from time hereafter be given or made by him

Within of them &c of notes we received now be it known  
that the said George Schley the holder to secure the pay-

granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents  
grant bargain and sell unto the said "The Bank of the  
State of Georgia" and its assigns forever all the following

County Known by the Number one hundred and forty  
four (144) originally granted to William Lewis all  
that lot of land in the fifteenth district of Henry  
County in the said State Known by the number one hundred  
& thirty one originally granted to Daniel Dunaway all  
that lot of land in the ninth district of Monroe County  
Known by the number one hundred & thirty nine (139)

Together with all the right title & interest of the said George Schley therin to have and to hold the said lots with all or parcels of land unto the said "The Bank of the State of Georgia" and its assigns forever provided nevertheless that if the said George Schley his heirs executors administrators or assigns shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said "The Bank of the State of Georgia" or its assigns the moneys due and to become due on the said promissory notes or on any notes that may be given in recurrance of the same or either of them or of notes in recurrance as herein before stated then this indenture and all the Estate and interest herein conveyed shall cease and be utterly null & void but if default shall be made in the payment of the said promissory notes or of any notes that may be given in recurrance of the same or either of them or of notes in recurrance as before stated it is now mutually covenanted and agreed that it shall be lawfull for the said "The Bank of the State of Georgia" or its assigns to grant bargains sell convey all & singular the said lots of land or any or either of them according to the act of the General Assembly in such case made & provided In witness whereof the said George Schley hath hereunto set his hand and seal on the day and year first above written
