day of March in the year of our Lord aforesaid payable
to William Law sixty one days after its date and endorsed
delivered by the said William Law to the said Bank of the
State of Georgia And whereas the said George Schley also
stands indebted at the date of these presents in the further
sum of twenty seven hundred & fifty four dollars upon his
certain other promissory note for that amount now running
in the said Bank dated the twentieth day of March aforesaid
payable to John Schley sixty one days after the date thereof
and endorsed and delivered by the said John Schley to the said
The Bank of the State of Georgia And whereas the said
George Schley also stands indebted in the further sum of
ninety hundred & twenty dollars upon his certain other
promissory note for that amount now running in the
said Bank dated the twenty fourth day of March aforesaid
payable to John Schley sixty one days after its date and endorsed
by the said John Schley to William Schley and endorsed and
delivered by the said William Schley to the said The Bank of the State
of Georgia And whereas the said George Schley also stands
indebted in the further sum of twenty seven hundred and twenty
dollars upon his certain other promissory note for that amount
now running in the said Bank dated the twenty fourth day
of March aforesaid payable to John Schley sixty one days after
its date and endorsed by the said John Schley to John A. Cobb
and endorsed and delivered by the said John A. Cobb to the
said The Bank of the State of Georgia And whereas the said
George Schley also stands indebted in the further sum of
Eighteen hundred dollars upon his certain other promissory
note for that amount now running in the said Bank
dated the thirty first day of March aforesaid payable to
A. B. Davis sixty one days after its date and endorsed and
delivered by the said A. B. Davis to the said The Bank of the
State of Georgia And whereas the said George Schley
now stands further indebted to the said The Bank of the
State of Georgia in the further sum of one thousand dollars
upon his certain other promissory note for that amount
now running in the said Bank dated the thirty first
day of March aforesaid payable to the said The Bank of the
State of Georgia sixty one days after the date thereof And
as the said George Schley is desirous of securing
The Bank of the State of Georgia the payment of
promissory notes or of any notes that may at any
time hereafter be given in payment of the same

either of them or of notes in renewal now be it known
that the said George Schley the better to secure the pay-
ment to the said "The Bank of the State of Georgia" of the said
promissory note or of any note that may at any time
or times hereafter be given in renewal of the same or
either of them or of notes in renewal according to the
tenor and effect of the same with the same endorser
or such other endorser as the said Bank may from
time to time or at any time accept or agree to and in

granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents
grant bargain and sell unto the said "The Bank of the
State of Georgia" and its assigns forever all the following

four (144) originally granted to William Lewis all
that lot of land in the sixteenth district of Henry
County in the said State known by the number one hundred
& thirty one originally granted to Daniel Dunlavy all
that lot of land in the ninth district of Monroe County
known by the number one hundred & thirty nine (139)
originally granted to Peter Letony all that lot of land
in the thirteenth district of Henry County known by the
number fifty eight (58) originally granted to William
Scott all that lot of land in the fourth district of Mon-
roe County known by the number seventy nine (79)

and agreed that it shall be lawfull for the said "The Bank
of the State of Georgia" or its assigns to grant bargain sell
convey all & singular the said lots of land or any or either of
them according to the act of the General Assembly in such
case made & provided In witness whereof the said George
