Georgia. On this Indenture made this twentieth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four between Gibbon B. Peagin of said County of the one part & the Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company of the other part witnesseth that the said Gibbon B. Peagin for and in consideration of running this contemplated Rail Road on and along his land as well as in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents to the number whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company & their successors & assigns the Right of Way on which to pass at all times by themselves Directors' Officers Agents & Servants & Servants in any manner they may think proper and particularly for the purpose of running erecting and establishing thereon a Rail Road with the requisite number of tracks pursuant to a charter of incorporation passed the County first day of December eighteen hundred and thirty three and renewed at subsequent Sittings of the General Assembly by amending Banking Laws and the privilege of extending the Road from Madison to the Southern terminus of the Western & Atlantic Rail Road And to this now the limit of said Right of way shall extend in width thirty three and one third ($33\frac{1}{3}$) yards on each side of the center line of the Road of the said Rail Road when completed and so continued in length thought the whole tract of land owned and claimed by said Peagin situate lying & being in Newton & DeKalb Counties adjoining lands of W. Barlett on the east being part of lot number 20 in the sixteenth section principally lying now Newton & DeKalb Counties and running in such direction through said tract of land as the said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company by their Engineers shall think best suited for the purpose of locating & establishing their works and connected with said Right of way the said company

shall have the right to cut down and remove all bushes
trees underwood and other growth and timber on each
side of Said Road as well as by felling or otherwise
the same upon the rails or other parts of said Road
together with all and singular the Rights, franchises & privileges
pertaining to the Said Strip of parcel of Land being belonging or
in any case appertaining and more especially the right of
way over the same. So have and to hold the same unto the
Said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company thenceforward
and forever to their own proper use benefit and behoof forever
in fee simple upon Condition and it is expressly understood
that howevel the Said Rail Road contemplation aforesaid
be not located and established on and along said Strip
but or parcel of land described in the above foregoing
indenture then said indenture is to be wholly null and void
and of no effect and the Said Razin for himself his
heirs and assigns will warrant and defend the title
then of me to the Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company
their successors & assigns against the claims of all persons
