 day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and forty four between Hazel Lovell of
 the one part and Samuel Howard of the other parts
 Hazel Lovell of the said State and County of DeKalb
 & Samuel Howard of the State of South Carolina humbly
 witnesseth that the said Hazel Lovell for
 and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred
 Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Howard
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath this day
 bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain
 and sell unto him the said Samuel Howard his heirs
 and assigns all the half tract or half lot of land
 situate lying and being in the County of DeKalb &
 known and distinguished by lot number One hundred
 and ninety seven in the fifth tenth District of originally
 being now DeKalb County Commencing at the north
 west corner of said lot and running due west to
 the original north west corner of said lot of land
 then along the original west line running due north
 to a state corner made in said line in a division of said
 lot whistlet corner by William Jackson thence due east
 along a line from north to south to state corner thence
 due north to the original north east corner of said
 lot of land To have and to hold the said half lot
 of land with all and singular the rights appertaining
 thereto unto the said Samuel Howard his heirs
 and assigns forever whatsover to the said half lot of
 land being belonging or in any wise appertaining with
 the remainder & remainders mesuages & tenements unto
 him and his heirs thence to the only proper use benefit
 & behoof of him the said Samuel Howard his heirs
 administrators and assigns in full simple and the said
 Hazel Lovell his heirs Executors & administrators the
 said bargain promises unto the said Samuel Howard
 his heirs Executors administrators and assigns against the
 said Hazel Lovell his heirs Executors and administrators

 warrant and forever defend by virtue of these presents
