before the sealing and delivering of these presents the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
bargained sold and conveyed unto the said Ottie Bryan
his heirs and assigns all that lot of land known
and distinguished by its twenty six (26) in the Fourteenth
District of originally being now Dekalb County

To have and to hold said tract or parcel of land
unto him the said Ottie Bryan his heirs and assigns
together with all and singular the rights, members &
appurtenances therof to the same in any manner belonging
to his and their own proper use benefit and behoof
forever in fee simple. And the said Joseph Boswell
for himself his heirs executors and administrators
the said bargained premises unto the said Ottie Bryan
his heirs and assigns will warrant and forever defend
the rights and titles thereof against themselves and
against the claim of all other persons whatever.
