Georgia This indenture made this twenty ninth
of March County day of January between humboldt and
forty four dollars Humboldt Waide of this County of the one
part and Charles Murphy and Isham J. Wood partners
and practitioners in the practice of Law using the firm
name and style of Murphy & Wood of this County of
the other part witnesseth that the said Humboldt Waide
together with one Hampton Waide hath this day made &
delivered to the said Murphy & Wood his certain promissory
note subscribed with his hand and bearing com
plete with these presents whereby the said Humboldt Waide
hath promised to pay to the said Murphy & Wood or them
fifty dollars on day after the date thereof for value
received Now for and in consideration of the sum of
fifteen dollars by the said Murphy & Wood to the said Humboldt
Waide in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknow
ledged as well as for the better securing the payment of
the said promissory note the said Humboldt Waide hath granted
bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant bargain
and sell unto the said Murphy & Wood their & each of
them heirs and assigns All that tract or parcel of Land
situate lying and being in the sixteenth (16) District of
Oconee County Henry but now DeKalb County containing
hundred (100) acres more or less known & distinguished
in the plan of said District by the number Sixty six
said tract or parcel of land lying and being in the north east
corner of said lot and bounded by a branch running East through

of land together with all the rights, minerals & appurtenances
thereof whatsoever to said tract or parcels of land belonging
or appertaining and also all the estate, right, title interest
property claim and demands of said tract or parcels of
land in law, Equity or otherwise because of his or to the
same belonging. To have and to hold the said tract
premises to the said Murphy & Wood their and each of them
hers and assigns to them own proper use benefit and
behold form and the said Huldaah Waid for herself
her heirs executors and administrators the said bargaining
parties unto the said Murphy & Wood with warrant
and power specially given against the claim of himself and
her heirs and against the claim of all other persons
whatsoever PROVIDED nevertheless that if the said Huldaah
Waid her heirs executors and administrators shall and
do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the
said Murphy & Wood their and each of them hers and
assigns the aforesaid sum of fifty dollars on the
day and time mentioned and appointed for the payment
of the same in this promissory note mentioned with legal
interest for the same according to the term of same and
then as well this present indenture will the right to
the property thereby conveyed as the said promissory note
shall leave the same and be void to all intents and
purposes In testimony whereof the said Huldaah Waid
hath caused to set her hand and seal the day and year
