Dekalb County 3 facias issued out of a Justice court of the
County of DeKalb at the suit of William Hallamore against
Warrington Knight, Isaac N Johnson Sheriff of the

the price or sum of eighty dollars now this indenture made
this the fourth day of February in the year of our Lord one
Thousand eight hundred and thirty four between Isaac
N Johnson Sheriff as aforesaid of the one part and the said
John Knight of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Isaac N Johnson Sheriff as aforesaid for and in consideration of
the sum of eighty dollars to him in hand paid by the said
John Knight at and before the sealing and delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain
and sell so far as the office of Sheriff authorizes him unto
the said John Knight his heirs and assigns all that
tract or parcel of land known and distinguished in the plan
of survey by lot number one hundred and thirty in the
fifteenth district of originally Henry now DeKalb County
containing two hundred two and a half acres More or less
together with all and singular the rights members and
appurtenances thereof unto the said lot of land being belong-
ing or in any wise appertaining and also the legal right
title interest property claim and demand of the said
Warrington Knight in law equity or otherwise whatever
of in or to the same to have and to hold the said tract or parcel
of land and premises and every part thereof unto the said John
Knight his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple to their own
proper use benefit and behoof in as full and ample a manner
as the said Warrington Knight or his heirs and assigns did or
might have held and enjoyed the same had it not been
seized and sold under the execution aforesaid In
Witness whereof the said Isaac N Johnson Sheriff as
aforesaid hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his
