more or less known & distinguished in the plan of Survey
by number three hundred and fifty three (353) in the sixth
district (6) of originally Turnite now Dekalb County
to have and to hold the same together with the appur-
tenances being or in any wise belonging thereto to his own
proper use benefit and behoof forever more in the like
manner as he himself may desire and require
I the said James will warrant and defend the rights
and title from myself my heirs executors and administrators
and from the just claim of all and every other person
or persons whatsoever to the said Gardner his heirs executors

the said Isaac Towns for and in consideration of the
sum of seven thousand dollars to the said Isaac Towns
in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath
granted bargained sold and conveyed and doth by these presents
grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Joseph Walker
his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land
situate lying and being in the County of originally Turnite
now Dekalb fifteenth District known and distinguished
on the plan of said District by the number two
hundred and fifty one containing two hundred and two
and a half acres more or less to have and to hold said
tract or parcel of land unto him the said Joseph
Walker his heirs and assigns together with all and
