acknowledged hath granted bargain and sold and
conveyed and does by these presents grant bargain
sell and convey unto the said William Blathrook
his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of
land situate lying and being in the fourth tenth district
of the County of DeKalb Georgia and distinguished
the plan of the said district by the number one
containing two hundred two and half acres more
or less with all the rights members appurtenances
thereunto belonging. He have and to hold the above
described lot of land unto him the said William
Blathrook his heirs and assigns together with all the
rights members and appurtenances to the said lot of
land in any wise belonging to his and thereunto
use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple and
the said Osborn M Lowry for himself his heirs
executors and administrators the said bargain premises
together with the right title and possessions thereof unto
the said William Blathrook his heirs and assigns will
warrant and forever defend the right and title thereof
against themselves and against the claim of all other
