and assigns all that tract or parcel of land lying and being
in the county of Henry known and distinguished by lot
no one hundred and thirty in the fifthteenth District of said
County to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land
unto the said Harrington Knight his heirs and assigns together
with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging
to him and his own proper benefit and behoof forever
in fee simple and the said James Carroll doth warrant the
same from his heirs executors and administrators the said
