 Company these his and assigns all that tract or parcel of  
 land situate lying and being in the County of DeKalb  
 known and distinguished by lot No. 25 thirty seven in the  
 eighth tenth district of originally Henry now DeKalb County  
 containing one hundred & fifty two and one half acres  
 more or less it being three fourths of the above lot No.
