these presents whereby the said Nicholas Sop hath promis-
ised pay the said Jos. Milligan or bearer fifty four dol-
lars and thirty seven & a half cents on or before the twenty
fifth of December next ensuing the date hereof for value
received now for and in consideration of the sum
of five dollars by the said Jos. Milligan to the said Nicholas
Sop in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
well as for the better securing the payment of the aforesaid
promissory note the said Nicholas Sop hath granted
bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant bar-
gin and sale unto the said Jos. Milligan his heirs and
