Jas. Millican of the same place Witnesseth that the
said Nicholas Pop hath this day made and delivered
to the said Jas. Millican his certain promissory note
subscribed with his hand and bearing even date with
these presents whereby the said Nicholas Pop hath prom-
ised pay the said Jas. Millican or his assigns fifty four dol-
lars and thirty seven and a half cents on or before the
fifth of December next ensuing the date hereof for value
received Now for and in consideration of the sum
of five dollars by the said Jas. Millican to the said Nich-
olas Pop in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
as well as for the better securing the payment of the aforesaid
promissory note the said Nicholas Pop hath granted
bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant bar-
gain and sell unto the said Jas. Millican his heirs and
assigns all that tract or lot of land lying and being situate
in the Sixteenth District of DeKalb County containing
Two hundred Two and a half acres be the same more
or less and known and distinguished in the plan of
said District by number Sixty four (64) To have and to
hold said bargained premises to the said Jas.
Millican his heirs and assigns to his and their own
proper use benefit and behoof forever and the said
Nicholas Pop for himself his heirs executors and admin-
istrators the said bargained premises unto the said
Jas. Millican will warrant and forever defend
against the claims of himself and his heirs and against
the claim of all other persons whatsoever present or
future that if the said Nicholas Pop his heirs executors
and administrators shall and do well and
truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said
Jas. Millican his heirs and assigns the
aforesaid sum of fifty four dollars
