and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
of is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed
and so by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the
said Hardy Evey his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel
of land situate lying and being in the County of originally
Henry but now Sokal County said tract or parcel of land is situate
lying and being in the fourteenth district of the said
and is known and distinguished in the plan of said district
by number fifty one (51) to have and to hold said tract or
parcel of land unto him the said Hardy Evey his heirs and
assigns together with all and singular the rights members
and appurtenances thereof to the same in any manner
belonging to him and his own proper use benefit and
enjoyment forever in fee simple and the said James Padon for him
self his heirs executors and administrators the said bargain
premises unto the said Hardy Evey his heirs and assigns with
warrant and forever defend the right and title thereof
against themselves and against the claim of all other
