Nash of the one part & State & County of said other part Witnesseth that the said Edward L. Nash for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty five Dollars to him in hand paid at & before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted bargain sold & conveyed & do by these presents grant & assign all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County originally known now D. Kall County and being the north half of Lot No 109 one hundred and sixty run in the 18th Eighteenth district originally known now D. Kall, originally granted to James Ryland said Grant being dated 22nd Novmbr 1824 To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land unto him the said Jackson Nash his heirs & assigns together with all & singular the rights members & appurtenances thereof to the same in any manner belonging to his & their own proper use benefit and behoof for ever for himself and the said Edward L. Nash for promises unto the said Jackson Nash his heirs & assigns will warrant and forever defend the rights & titles thereof persons whatever in Whose whomever the said Edward L. Nash hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day and date above written this 18 January 1833. (in testimony before us)

Kall County containing two hundred & two & a half acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the said lot of land with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances thereof unto the said Alex Braswell being belonging to him and his heirs and assigns forever
