

Georgia DeKalb County ³/₄ of said County and State of Georgia for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear towards my daughter Eliza Caroline Murphy I do hereby give alien and convey unto Lindsey Johnson of the County of Cap in said State (in trust for my said Daughter Eliza Caroline) forever three Negro Slaves for life (to wit) a woman by the name of Hannah of dark complexion about thirty years of age and her two Children Matilda a yellow girl about nine years of age and Robert a boy of dark complexion about 5 years of age To have and to hold said Slaves in trust and for the support and sole use of my said Daughter Eliza Caroline during her natural life and to her Children and free from any claim lien or right which might otherwise be created by Marriage the said Slaves to remain in my possession free from any charge for their services and free from any expense to her or her trustee until my said Daughter arrives at the age of twenty one years or marries unless in my judgement the interest of my daughter will be promoted by delivering them sooner to her or her trustee And in case this trust should be void by death resignation or otherwise I reserve to myself the right to appoint another should I be in life and in case of my death I vest that appointment in the Superior Court of the County in which my said Daughter may reside at the time In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 17th day of May 1845 Signed sealed and delivered in

Robbins of the part both of the County & State aforesaid Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars in hand paid by the said A. S. Robbins unto the said James Shipley at & before the sealing signing & delivering of these presents hath granted bargained sold & do by these presents grant bargain sell unto the said A. S. Robbins all that tract or parcel of land lying & being in the 14th dist formerly Fayette County now DeKalb it being the east half of lot No. 44) Number forty four containing one hundred acres more or less To have & to hold the said tract or parcel of land & to be divided North & South by a center road leading from where A. McKee formerly lived to the old place together with all the appurtenances

thereunto belonging or any vice appertaining therunto
the said bargained premises forever in fee simple unto the
said Ad Robbins his heirs & assigns to his & their own
proper use benefit & behoof of him the said Ad Robbins his
heirs executors administrators & assigns & the said James
Shippey for himself his heirs executors administrators &
assigns doth warrant & forever defend the right &
title of same against the claim of himself his heirs & assigns
& the claim of all & any other person whomsoever lawfully
claiming the same in witness whereof the said James
Shippey doth hereunto set his hand and affixed his

year of the independence of the United States of America
between Nahaly Stouns of the State and County aforesaid
of the one part and Thomas Stouns of the County of
Elbert & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth
that the said Nahaly Stouns for and in consideration
of the sum of three hundred and eighty dollars to her
in hand paid by the said Thomas Stouns at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold
aliened relinquished and conveyed and does by these
presents grant bargain sell alien relinquish & convey
unto the said Thomas Stouns his heirs and assigns all
his right title interest and claim of some in and to
the Prises of Lewis Stouns her late husband late of DeKalb
County deceased being one undivided third part (according
to quantity & quantity) of late Number two hundred and
thirty two and two hundred forty nine in the Eleventh dist
of County Newton now DeKalb County containing
two hundred two & a half acres each more or less
