paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to the grantor bargained  
and sold and conveyed and do by these presents grant bargain  
sell and convey unto the said Lewis G. Walker his heirs and  
assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate in the County  
of formerly Henry but now DeKalb County all the land lying  
on the said the said of Rivers Creek on lot No. 44  
fourteen in the eleven hundred District and a part of lot  
No. 313 there hundred and three in the eight hundred District  
of said County beginning at the said west corner of said  
lot thence East to a branch there down said branch  
to John D. Evans corner thence on said line to the Mill  
Creek thence said said creek to the original line thence  
on said line to the beginning corner with the exceptions  
of a mill yard containing of about eight acres more  
or less. To have and to hold the said tract or parcels  
of land unto him the said Lewis G. Walker his heirs  
and assigns together with all and singular the rights  
privileges and appurtenances thereto to the same in any  
manner belonging to him and his own proper uses benefits  
and behoove general in fee simple and the said James W. Rivers  
for his Executors and Trustees the said bargained premises

warrant and power defined the right and title thereto against  
themselves and against the claim of all other persons whatever.
