the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the grantor herein
to sold and conveyed and do by these presents grant bargain
sell and convey unto the said Lewis G. Walker his heirs and
assigns all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County
of formerly King but now DeKalb County all the land lying
on the south side of Paines Creek on lot No 14
fourteen in the South fourth District and a part of lot
No 303 then hundred and then in the Eighteenth District
of said County beginning at the South west corner of said
lot thence East to a branch thence down said branch
to John D Evans corner thence on said line to the mill
creek thence down said creek to the original line thence
on said line to the beginning corner with the exception
of a mill yard containing of twenty eight acres more
or less. To have and to hold the said tract or parcels
of land unto him the said Lewis G. Walker his heirs
and assigns together with all and singular the rights
members and appurtenances thereof to the same in any
manner belonging to him and his own proper use benefit
and behoof forever in fee simple and the said Jas W Rice
for his Executors and Admins the said bargain bargain

warrant and force defend the right and title thereof against
