 of the estate & effects of Veper F. Churland deceased the being of

 Crockett of the County of DeKalb in said State of the
 other part Whereby that the said Mary F. Churland
 administratrix aforesaid in consideration that he the said
 Veper F. Churland in his lifetime (to wit) on the thirteenth
 day of April in the year eighteen hundred and thirty one
 gave his bond to him the said Robert Crockett to make
 to him titles to the several tracts pieces and parcels of land
 hereinafter mentioned and departed this life without ever
 having executed said titles and he the said Robert Crockett
 having applied to the honorable the Court of Ordinary of

Now therefore said Mary F. Cherland administrator aforesaid in consideration of the premises aforesaid hath granted bargain sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby bargain sell assign convey and confirm unto him the said Robert Crankitt and his heirs & assigns the following tracts & parcels of land (viz) lot Number forty two the west half of lot number one hundred and one and also the west half of lot Number forty nine all situate lying and being in the Eighth District of Originally Henry County now in the County of DeKalb in said State which last mentioned half lot is bounded as follows: Commencing on an Oak tree on the Lawrenceville road on the North line of said lot 11 chains from the N. E. corner of said lot. Thence a straight line through said lot running in a direction to strike the South line of said lot 11 chains from the South west corner of said lot N. 49 to the corner between Benjamin Burdett's land and C.
