day of October in the year eighteen hundred
and forty four between Jesse Sully of the County and State of Iowa
of the one part and John T. Sabney of the same place of the
other part Witnesseth that the said Jesse Sully hath this
day made and delivered to the said John T. Sabney his two
certain promissory notes subscribed with his hand and bearing
own date with these presents whereby the said Jesse Sully
by one of said notes promised by the twenty fifth day of
December next after the date thereof to pay the said John
T. Sabney or bearer thirty dollars for value received and by
the other one of said notes the said Jesse Sully promised by
the twenty fifth day of December Eighteen hundred and
forty five to pay the said John T. Sabney or bearer fifty
seven dollars and seven cents for value received And for
and in consideration of the sum of five dollars by the
said John T. Sabney in hand paid to the said Jesse Sully
the receipt wherof is hereby acknowledged as well as for
the better securing the payment of aforesaid promissory
notes the said Jesse Sully hath granted bargain and sold
and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell unto
the said John T. Sabney his heirs and assigns the north
half of lot of land number one hundred and thirteen
located being and being in the Eighteenth District of original
Henry but now Seale County the said north half of said

lot of land containing one hundred and one acres more or less
 more or less with the all and singular the right title and
 and appurtenances to the said half lot of land in any way
 appertaining or belonging. To have and to hold the said bargain
 bargain premises unto the said John T. Dabney his heirs and
 assigns to his and their own proper use benefit and enjoy-
 form and the said Sps Sally for himself his heirs and
 ton and administrators the said bargain premises unto the
 said John T. Dabney will warrant and forever defend
 against the claim of himself and against the claim
 of all other persons whatever. Proven unto me that
 if the said Sps Sally his heirs executors and administrators
 shall and do will and truly pay or cause to be paid unto
 the said John T. Dabney his heirs and assigns the afore-
 mentioned sum of eighty seven dollars and seven cents on the
 days and terms mentioned and appointed for the payment
 thereof in the said two promissory notes mentioned with lawful
 interest for the same according to the tenor of said two promissory
 notes then and from thenceforth as well the present interest
 and the right to the property thereby conveyed as the said
 two promissory notes shall cease determine and be void
