Dekalb County December in the year Eighteen hundred and
forty two before Sethro Baker and Willis Brown
of said County witnesseth that the said Sethro Baker hath
this day made & delivered to the said Willis Brown his certain
provisary note described with his hand & bearing even date
with these presents whereby the said Sethro Baker hath promised
to pay the said Willis Brown or bearer four hundred
& seventy seven dollars & Eighty seven cents By the twenty
fifth day of December 1843 for value received Now for & in con-
sideration of the sum of five dollars by the said Willis Brown
to the said Sethro Baker in hand paid the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged as well as for the better securing the
payment of said provisary note the said Sethro Baker hath
granted bargained & sold & doth by these presents grant
bargain & sell unto said Willis Brown his heirs and
assigns the following property to wit the fourth part of
lot of land number nine in the fourteenth district of
originally Henry now Dekalb County supposed to contain
Sixty five acres lying in the south east corner
of said lot & also the following slaves to wit one woman
by the name of Rachael of yellow complexion about twenty
five years old & her two children Lucy a girl about three
years old and said Rachael's youngest child the same
being a female & now about two years old To have &
hold of said bargained property to the said Willis Brown his
heirs & assigns to his & their own proper use benefit & beh-
eif forever and the said Sethro Baker for himself his
heirs executors & administrators the said bargained prop-
erty unto said Willis Brown will remain & forever de-
pend against the claim of himself & his heirs & against the
claim of all other persons whatever provided nevertheless
that if the said Sethro Baker his heirs executors & adminis-
trators shall & do well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto
the said Willis Brown his heirs & assigns the aforesaid
sum of Four hundred & seventy seven dollars & 87 cents on
the day & time mentioned & appointed for the payment
thereof in the said provisary note mentioned with
duefull interest for the same according to the tenor of said
note thence from thence forth as well this present indent
ure & the rights to the property thereby conveyed as the said
provisary note shall cease determine & be void to all in-
tents & purposes in testimony whereof the said Sethro
Baker hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day &
year above written signed sealed & delivered in presence
of James Mc Calloch
