lying and being in the town of Eatonton and State of Georgia
and distinguished in the plan of said town as number one
hundred and twenty two 122 lying on the South side of
said town to have and to hold the same together with
all and singular the rights numbers and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or appertaining in as full and ample
measure as the said deceased had and held the same to hold
June 13. Butter his heirs and assigns and the said Adminis-
trator doth warrant and defend to the said June 13. Butter
his heirs and assigns all the right title and interest of
said deceased in and to the premises and no more.
