Now this Indenture made the 4th day of December in the year

other part Witnesseth that the said John Brown Deputy
Sheriff for and in consideration of the sum of Forty six dollars
to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Stevens at and before the
Sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these
presents doth grant bargain and sell so far as the office of
Deputy Sheriff authorizes him unto the said Thomas Stevens
his heirs and assigns all that fraction of land known and
distinguished in the plan of the Seventeenth district of orig-
inally Henry Now De Kalb County by the number (260) two
hundred and forty one except twenty acres more which has
been run off of said fraction together with all and singular
the rights incidents and appurtenances thereof unto the said
fraction of land being belonging or in any wise appertaining
and also the estate right title interest property claim and demand
word of the said Frederick Hilsabek in law equity or otherwise
whatsoever of in or to the same To have and to hold the said
fraction of land and premises and every part thereof unto the said
