in consideration of one hundred and fifty dollars to him
in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both
bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain and
sell unto Dury Lee his heirs or assigns a certain parcel
of land containing fifty acres more or less it being one
fourth part of lot No 20 number twenty in the eighteenth
district formerly Murray now Schall County it being in
the north east corner of said lot together with all and
singular the rights members and appurtenances thereto
unto the said parcel of land belonging or in any wise
appertaining to the same To have and to hold said
said parcel of land unto the said Dury Lee his heirs
and assigns to their own proper use benefit and behoof
forever in full sample and the said Andrew Johnson
