of said County of the one part and the Georgia Rail Road and
Banking Company of the other part witnesseth that the said
John C. Austin for and in consideration of running the un-
completed Rail Road on and along his land as well as in
condition of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid
at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents to
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted
bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant
bargain and sell unto the said Georgia Rail Road and Banking
Company and their successors and assigns the Right of Way
which to pass at all times by them to Director of
himself and Successors in any manner they may see fit
particularly for the purpose of running and operating
through a Rail Road with the greatest convenience
and to a charter of no less than ten years to be

Begun on eighteen hundred and thirty three and continued at
Subsequent Sittings of the General Assembly by conferring Banking
Privileges and the privilege of extending the Road from Madison
to the Southern terminus of the Western & Atlantic Rail Road &
to this end the limit of said Right of Way shall extend in
width thirty three yards on each side of the centre line of the
Road May of the said Rail Road when completed and to extend
in length through the whole tract of land above and claimed
by the said John C Austin situate lying and being in Dekalb
County adjoining lands of Davis George & others and running in
such direction through said tract of land as the said Georgia
Rail Road & Banking Company by their Engineers shall think
best suited for the purpose of locating and establishing their
works and connected with said Right of Way the said Company
shall have the right to cut down and remove all such trees
and underwood and other growth and timber on each side of said
Road as would by falling on or breaking the same injure
the Rail or other parts of said Road In addition to the above
the said John C Austin for and in consideration of the sum
of twenty five dollars to him in hand paid at and before the
sealing and delivery of these presents to the receipt whereof witness
acknowledged hath in connection with the right of way herein granted
bargained and sold and by these presents to the said rail road company
and will unto the said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company
all the above described tract of land lying on the north side of
the present location line of said Rail Road with the express
intention that the said Georgia Rail Road shall not be constructed
south of its present location along the banks of the river Edna
& Austin together with all and singular the rights, members
and appurtenances to said High tract or parcel of land being
bearing or in any wise appertaining unto them especially the
right of way over the same to have and to hold the same
unto the said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company their
successors and assigns to them own proper use benefit and behoof
forever in fee simple upon condition and it is expressly under-
stood that should the said Rail Road be implanted as aforesaid
be not located and established on and along said High tract or
parcel of land described in the above & foregoing instrument then
said intention is to be wholly null and void and of no effect
and the said John C Austin for his heirs and assigns will
warrant and defend the title thereby unto the Georgia Rail Road
& Banking Company their successors & assigns against the claim
